John 3:16 (NIV) *For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.*

Matthew 5:17 (NIV) *Do not think that I have come to abolish the Law or the Prophets; I have not come to abolish them but to fulfill them.*

Luke 23:33 (NIV) *When they came to the place called the Skull, they crucified him there, along with the criminals—one on his right, the other on his left.*

Luke 23:34 (NIV) *Jesus said, “**Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing.**” And they divided up his clothes by casting lots.*

Isaiah 53:12 (ESV) *because he poured out his soul to death and was numbered with the transgressors; yet he bore the sin of many, and makes intercession for the transgressors*

Matthew 26:28 (NIV) *This is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins*

Psalms 3:7 (NIV) *Arise, LORD!

Strike all my enemies on the jaw;  
break the teeth of the wicked.*

Luke 6:28 (NIV) *But to you who are listening I say: Love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, <sup>28</sup> bless those who curse you, pray for those who mistreat you.*

Romans 3:23-24 (ESV) *for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, <sup>24</sup> and are justified by his grace as a gift, through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus,*

Romans 6:23 (NIV) *For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.*

Matthew 5:43-44 (NIV) *“You have heard that it was said, ‘Love your neighbor and hate your enemy.’ <sup>44</sup> But I tell you, love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you,*

Romans 12:17-18 (NIV) *Never pay back evil with more evil. Do things in such a way that everyone can see you are honorable. <sup>18</sup> Do all that you can to live in peace with everyone. v. 19 - Dear friends, never take revenge.*

Colossians 3:13-14 (NIV) *Bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone. Forgive as the Lord forgave you. <sup>14</sup> And over all these virtues put on love, which binds them all together in perfect unity.*
