“It Is Finished”

Psalms 69:21 (NIV) *They put gall in my food and gave me vinegar for my thirst.*

John 19:29-30 (NIV) *A jar of wine vinegar was there, so they soaked a sponge in it, put the sponge on a stalk of the hyssop plant, and lifted it to Jesus' lips. **When he had received the drink, Jesus said, “It is finished.”** With that, he bowed his head and gave up his spirit.*

Tetelestai (tay-TEL-es-tie)

Jeremiah 29:11 (NIV) *“**For I know the plans I have for you,**” declares the Lord, “plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.”*

Revelation 3:2 (NIV) *Wake up! Strengthen what remains and is about to die, for **I have found your deeds unfinished in the sight of my God.***

Acts 20:24 (NIV) *However, I consider my life worth nothing to me; **my only aim is to finish the race and complete the task the Lord Jesus has given me**—the task of testifying to the good news of God's grace.*

Deuteronomy 11:18 (NIV) **Fix these words of mine in your hearts and minds;** tie them as symbols on your hands and bind them on your foreheads.

Matthew 5:37 (NKJV) *But **let your ‘Yes’ be ‘Yes,’ and your ‘No,’ ‘No.’** For whatever is more than these is from the evil one.*

Luke 14:28-30 (MSG) *Is there anyone here who, planning to build a new house, doesn't first sit down and figure the cost so you'll know if you can complete it? If you only get the foundation laid and then run out of money, you're going to look pretty foolish. **Everyone passing by will poke fun at you: ‘He started something he couldn't finish.’***

Hebrews 12:2 (NIV) *fixing our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of faith. **For the joy set before him he endured the cross,** scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.*

2 Corinthians 8:11-12 (NIV) **Now finish the work,** so that your eager willingness to do it may be matched by your completion of it, according to your means. For if the willingness is there, the gift is acceptable according to what one has, not according to what one does not have.

Philippians 1:6 (NIV) *being confident of this, that **he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion** until the day of Christ Jesus.*
